Minimum Proposal Requirements:

- Résumé with qualifications for curriculum writing
- A writing sample
- Planned program outcomes
- Proposed fee with explanation breakdown
- A brief description of the researched principles that will be used to develop the learning objectives and activities

Curriculum developers must have permission to use any audio or video materials included in the curriculum, i.e. no public YouTube links without permission from the original content creator. If unique videos need to be created, please include that cost in the fee proposal. NMCDHH may request that the creator write a script for the video that NMCDHH will create.

Accepting this work will require the developer to be a vendor with the State of New Mexico and provide their BTIN.
