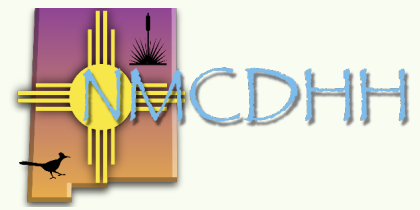


Paper Says What?
